It appearing to the Court that James Thomas administrator of the estate of Edmund Shackelford dec^d has given due and legal notice of his intention to apply to this Court for leave to sell the Negroes belonging to the estate of said deceased; and it further appearing that a sale of said negroes will be necessary in order to meet the demands against said estate. It is ordered that leave be granted said James Thomas administrator as aforesaid to sell the following negroes, to wit, a Negro man Jim about 43 years old, Woman Sylvia and her two children Jack & Porter; Woman Belia and 3 children Edmund Solomon & Elizabeth, and a girl Clara upon his giving due and legal notice thereof in terms of the law, in such cases made and provided.

It appearing to the Court that James Thomas administrator of the estate of Edmund Shackelford dec^d has given due and legal notice of his intention to apply to this Court for leave to sell the land belonging to the estate of said deceased and it further appearing to the Court that a sale thereof is necessary for paying the debts of said estate; It is ordered that leave be granted to the said James Thomas administrator as aforesaid to sell the following land to wit, four hundred and forty ~~acres~~ more or less in Hancock County on Paulsboro Creek or Back River adjoining Sterling Grand Green Haff and others; also 17 ~~acres~~ on Indian Creek in Morgan County adjoining John G. Colbert and others. upon his giving due and legal notice thereof in terms of the law.
