Thomas Clayton, John Graybill & Michael Graybill or a
majority of them be and they are hereby appointed Commis-
sioners, to divide the land negroes, and other personal property be-
longing to the Estate of George Butts equally between the said Mar-
tha W. Butts widow & George M. Butts in pursuance of said Will.

Agreeable to an order of the Inferior Court of Hancock County
when sitting as a Court of Ordinary to us directed bearing
date the fourth day of November 1833. we have proceeded to
view and set apart to Martha W. Butts widow of George Butts
decd. & George M. Butts as near equal parts of the Estate of
said decd. as in our judgment as the Estate was susceptible of.
viz, To the said Martha W. Butts negroes, Bob, Sarah & child,
Aggy & child, Fred, & Rose valued at two thousand & fifty dollars
one Bed, one cow half, four chairs, one cloth Bag, one Oven,
one Table, one clock reel valued at thirty nine dollars
and the East half of two hundred and twenty nine acres of
