McCulloh to have the management of my estate, untill my wife marries and then my childrens part of my estate to be managed by my executor Jos. P. McCulloh.

Should my wife marry before my youngest child becomes of age I wish my property divided so that she may have her part of the estate the remainder of which will remain together untill the youngest child becomes of age. January 27. 1832.
