In pursuance to an order from the Honorable the Superior Court of said County when sitting for Ordinary Purposes to us directed we proceeded to appraise and divide the residue of the Estate of Nelson Harris deceased and assign to Burwell Jackson in right of his wife formerly Clara Harris his distributive share; We find the Estate to be worth, three thousand two hundred and five ⁸⁴/₁₀₀ dollars and after taking the sum of eight hundred ¹⁶/₁₀₀ dollars, which leaves a balance of three thousand one hundred and twenty one ⁶⁴/₁₀₀ dollars, of which we assign to Burwell Jackson, one fifth part it being six hundred and twenty four ³²/₁₀₀ dollars, of this sum he drew agreeable to the Will one Negro girl at five hundred dollars, one bed and bedstead furniture at twenty five dollars, and one side Saddle at fourteen dollars - making the sum of five hundred and thirty nine dollars and the balance of eighty five ³²/₁₀₀ dollars to be paid him in effects.
