

Will of Aaron Weatherby

Georgia I Aaron Weatherby of said State
Harrison County being of sound and dis-
posing mind and memory do make this my last will and
testament.

Item First: I give and bequath to my Children Rebecca
Langley, Sarah Ann Harper, Isabell Jeffers, Louize
Melinda Aldridge, Charlott Morgan, Mathas W Weatherby
who are now in life, and Dortha Jackson, Isaac Hatt-
erby and James E. Weatherby my grand Children who
are the Children of my oldest Son Edmund J Weatherby
and to my wife Francis May Jane Weatherby all of
my property both real and personal of whatever
kind or description, the said Dortha Jackson and
Weatherby and James E. Weatherby grand Children
receiving only the one share, that of their deceased father
Edmund J Weatherby. This bequest is made to my
wife Francis May Jane Weatherby in lieu of dower
but it is my will that she shall receive a reason-
able twelve months support after my death.
