delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold unto the
said J. W. J. Watson his heirs & assigns a certain Town Lot in

Forty Two fifty feet fronting the public square & running One
hundred feet back on the North side of the public square
to have & to hold the said Town Lot unto the said J. W. J.

heirs & assigns the title to the said lot in the Town of Buchanan
