Satham Lots of Land No 461 474 480 734 735 736 737 738 739 740 in 30th Dist & 3rd Sect of Haralson County Containing each forty acres more or less also half of Lot No 427 in 30th Dist & 3rd Sect Haralson County Geo Containing Twenty acres more or less all valued at Twelve hundred Dollars

Satham two hundred Dollars in Cash to be paid to the said S. H. S. Satham by our son Thomas S. Satham and the same We Order shall be a Charge upon the Land herein before devised to the said S. S.
