the branch west to the ditch, thence the ditch to the line to the line house,
thence west across the patch, thence down the fence to the branch, thence
up the branch an hundred yards, thence and south to the original
line of lot of land seventy eight in the Eighth District of Originally Carroll
but now Haralson County, thence and east along the line to the point
first started from.

Item 6th I hereby disinherit my grand children heirs of my daughter
Nancy Bachus afterwards Nancy Jacobs who is now dead, to wit
William Jacobs, Mary Jacobs, Elizabeth Jacobs, Etta Jacobs, Sam
Jacobs heirs of my daughter Nancy Bachus, They and each of them
are hereby entirely excluded and disinherited from receiving or inher-
iting any part whatever of my estate.

Item 7th I will and bequeath my Household and Kitchen furniture of every kind
and description to my wife and my daughter herein named to share
equally in the same.

Item 8th I further will all my personal property to wit all my horses,
Wheels, Cattle, Hogs and Sundry and farming utensils of every kind
and description to my wife and daughter hereinbefore named.

Item 9th I will and bequeath all of my other property not herein named to
my children to wit Mary Bachus now Mary Davis Margaret Bachus
now Margaret Brown, Elizabeth Bachus, now Elizabeth Roberts, John
C Bachus Thomas Bachus, and James Bachus, to share equally in the
division of the same.

Item 10th I further bequeath that if I receive lot of land No. 72, in the Eighth
District of Originally Carroll but now Haralson County I will that
Twenty five Acres in the Northeast corner of the lot be the property of my
wife and daughters mentioned in the first part of this my will,
the remainder of said lot of land to my heirs mentioned in the last
part of my will.

Item 11th I hereby constitute and appoint my son Joseph C. W. Bachus executor
and attorney in law in and to the execution of this my last will and
Testament this September the 11th 1884.
