of the County of Haralson, of the second part, WITNESSETH, That the said part 1st of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of ~~one thousand five hundred~~ ^{one thousand five hundred} Dollars, in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said part 2^d of the second part, ~~his~~ ^{his} heirs and assigns, all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in ~~the~~ ^{the} 7th Dist. & 5th section of Haralson County Georgia, thirty acres more or less off the east end of fractional lot twenty five and sixty five acres more or less off the western end of fractional lot twenty six being all of said lot twenty six excepting and reserving fifty acres of the east end of said lot twenty six containing in all 95 acres more or less. The same being all the land we now hold as ours by deed or otherwise, exceptation herein reserved. George W. Head is to have the use & rents and pay all taxes and expenses of said premises but the title does not pass to or vest in him until the consideration herein named is fully paid.

(9) ninety, and being the north west one fourth of said lot 9 and being in the 7th section of said County and State.
