 shall decide it for them & such decision shall be final

 lives & after their death to their heirs of their body viz to
 Susanna Miller one hundred and twenty seven and one half acres

 Thomason the land upon which she now lives one hundred and
 fifty acres more or less of lot No Eighty seven Dist 1 sect 5

 Weatherston One hundred and fifty acres more or less of lot
 No 98 & 97 Dist 7 sect 5 Originally Carroll now Haralson County
 being the land upon which she now lives since I daughters or that
 to move off of said land & rent or lease it
