and kitchen furniture for the use of my wife and
minor children during their minority and for the use

widowhood if she should so die or again marry then
my executor that I will name in this will I will
cause said bequeathed property to be equally divided

Item 2nd I hereby give of the property that I have to my wife Easter A. Halecombe he and become insufficient for the support of my wife and my minor children I hereby direct my executor to furnish such deficiency out of the accrued interest on money loaned as before directed

Item 4th I hereby will that my three unmarried girls shall at their marriage or majority have a dowry of the value thereof

Item 5th I hereby direct my executor of the place that I have will to my wife or the proceeds thereof sufficient to give support to her and the minor children and keep said place in good repair it shall be the duty of my executor to make or cause to be made such needed repairs and pay for same out of funds in his hands belonging to my estate

Item 6th I hereby give and bequeath to my wife Easter A. Halecombe such stock and agricultural tools as will be needed for the proper cultivation of said farm with corn and forage for same

Item 7th If my executor should desire to be relieved of the trust he will see that the minors if there be any have guardians appointed in conformity of the law and will proceed to distribute the residue of my estate according to law of distribution of this estate

Item 8 If distribution has not been made before when the youngest child becomes of age 21 years old then distribution must be made equally between all of my heirs

Item 9th I hereby constitute and appoint my son in law Jesse Beale my executor of this my last will and testament
