 at the death of the said Deborah McIlhenny

 or unmarried at that time will hold the

 each of them one cow and half one bed-
 stead and feather bed and bedding at the

 W. Whisenant having already received
 her portion cow & half bed & bedding be-
 lieved.

Item 3rd Lot of land No (174) one hundred and
 seventy seven in the 6 & 5 of Originally
 Carroll but now said County be sold by my
 executors and the proceeds be appropriated
 in the payments of my indebtedness and
 the payments of all my just debts the residue
 to and be paid to my beloved wife Deborah
 McIlhenny for the support of herself and
 family and after the death of my
 beloved wife Deborah McIlhenny and Manager
 of all my five now single daughters the
 residue of said estate to be equally divided

by my Executors.

I hereby constitute and appoint my sons
Robert H. McElharg and Samuel J. McElharg
Executors to this my last Will and Testament
