has blessed me I do therefore make this my last Will and  
Testament hereby Revoking and annulling all others by  
me heretofore made

1st I Devise and Direct that my body be buried in a  
Decent and Christian like manner suitable to my  
Circumstances and conditions in life my sole trust shall  
be to rest with my God who gave it as I hope for  
Salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed  
Savior and Saviour Jesus Christ

2nd I Devise and direct that all my just Debts be paid within  
Delay by my Executor hereinafter named and appointed

3rd I Give and bequeath and devise to my beloved Wife  
Catherine and her children Six of Land to wit Two  
hundred two and one half acres and thirty acres  
being off of the South end of Lot 45 1/2 all of which  
is lying in the 7th Dist of originally Carroll now Haralson  
County with all the rights members and appurtenances  
to said Lot and Parcel of Land in any wise belonging  
free from all charge and limitations whatever to  
her and her children to wit Frank L. Carroll, Mary  
John and Elizabeth to their own proper use  
benefit and behoof for ever

I also give and bequeath to my beloved Wife and all  
Children before named in the same manner the  
following interests used on and belonging to the  
farm on said Land the household and kitchen  
furniture and all the things belonging on said  
the above named property be and remain for the  
benefit of my beloved Wife and her present children until  
at her death to remain until the youngest child  
be of her majority and no division to be made until  
the consent of two thirds of the above named

To my Daughter Martha & I Desire and bequeath  
and will leave and carry for her own benefit  
without interest

To my four eldest children Allin, Henry, Susan,  
Dennis and Amanda Culamore I give and  
bequeath One hundred acres more or less two  
acres heretofore given to Union Hill Church the  
above One hundred acres or parcel of Land being  
the East half of Lot 1097 and 1/2 District 15  
to be Divided Equally when two thirds of the in-  
terested shall agree thereto

Should my Wife marry again during the life  
of any of her present children then her part  
as contained in the third article of this Will  
to Revert to her present children without reserve  
or limitation as before named

Whereby constitute and appoint my tried friend  
R. B. Hutchinson and John S. Hamel Executors  
of this my last Will and Testament
