do make this my last Will and Testament,

Item 1st I give bequeath and devise to my wife Mary Williams and my daughters Priscilla E. Louiza, Della J. S. Dela, and Mary J. Williams the following property to wit, Lots of land No 73 & 1/2 of lot No 79. 7th Dist 5th Sect. Lots No 813, 816, 899, 897, 887 & ten acres more or less of 761 lying North of Tallapoosa River 20th Dist 3rd Sect & 683. 1st Dist 4th Sect, also town lots in the town of Buchanan said State and County to wit, Lots No 70, 71, 76, 77, 61, 62, 52, 53, 54, 56, 34, 35, 36, 30, & 50 & 51, known as the Brock place, also all my household and kitchen furniture and all my stock of all kinds and plantation and Mechanical tools also all debts due me from any and all persons whatever, said sums of money or the interest on the same to be used to pay the Tax on the above described property & is estimated said Daughters and Hezekiah Williams my son, all the above real estate to remain undivided until Mary J. becomes Eighteen years old & then all the above named property (except said sums set a part for the Support & Education of the children aforesaid, to be equally divided among the said Priscilla E. Louiza, Della J. S. Dela, & Mary J. This bequest free from all charge or limitation whatever, to their own proper use & benefit & be the use of said property given to my wife Mary Williams in lieu of whole Power

Item 2nd I give bequeath and devise to Mary Thompson Lots of land No 819 and all of 884 lying west of Tallapoosa River 20th Dist 3rd Section said land being sold to N & E Brown for Eight Bales of Cotton and he holds my bond for Title, if said Brown should pay to the said Mary Thompson said purchase money in Cotton then said Mary Thompson is to make to said Brown a Title to said land, and on failure to pay said Cotton said Brown is to pay rent on said land to said Mary Thompson my daughter.

Item 3rd I give bequeath and devise to my sons Harsec William & James Williams and my daughter Susan Emma Lots of land No 813 & 1/2 Dist 5th Sect. also one Steam Engine and one Mill.

Item 4th I give bequeath and devise to my son Wyatt Williams Lots of land No 813 & 1/2 Dist 5th Sect. also one Steam Engine and one Mill.

Item 5 I give, bequeath and devise to my sons Perry, Hiram and
Wegakidshi Williams lots of land N^o 171 & one half of lot 170
7th Dist and 5th Section and the Mitham...
Tenancies thereunto belonging Except the use of said Mill & Linn
to grind and Linn for the persons named in the first item of
this my Will to be free.

Item 6 I give, bequeath and devise to my daughter Aldora Simpson
the hire of her body lots of land N^o 880 - 1st Dist & 4th Section
and Forty acres of lot N^o 146 Dist 7th Sect 5th all the land
described in the above and foregoing lies in Haralson County,
Georgia
