Head, of the State of Georgia, of the County of Haralson, of the second part, WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars and other valuable consideration, in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the Seventh District and Fifth Section of Haralson County, Georgia, described as follows: All of fractional land lot number twenty six (26) containing eighty-four (84) acres, more or less.

This deed is made in lieu of deed made by same grantor to same grantee about the year 1912 concerning the same property and which has been lost, destroyed or mislaid, the same having never been recorded.
