State of Georgia I, Anna Adams being of sound disposing mind and memory
County of Harris and wishing to make a disposition of what property I possess
do make and constitute this my last will and testament revoking all wills
herebefore made by me

- Item 1st I wish my body after my death buried in a christian like manner suitable to
my circumstances in life
- Item 2^d I will and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Sarah Frances Adams four acres
of land to wit, Adjoining a portion of Cappin complexion about twenty-
eight years old and her son Hiram about one year old and Dennis
about ten years old of copper complexion and Nancy a girl about
eight years old of copper complexion also one feather bedstead of
two fine counterpanes fine quilts one cunition, one chest and one trunk
She is to choose her bed and bedding also five hundred dollars in money or
of my estate
- Item 3rd All the balance of my negro property I will to be equally divided between
my three slaves to wit, Andrew Joseph W. Adams, — Adams the negro
able not to be sold but left up to my said sons and should there be any dif-
ference in the value of the lots they are to be made equal by money, such
division to be made by three disinterested persons to be selected by my son
- Item 4th I will that all of my slaves & house holding after Sarah Frances selects hers to
be equally divided between my three sons Andrew Joseph W. and David
J. Adams they to divide them among themselves
- Item 5th I will that my crop, stock of deer hogs and all of my property not dis-
posed of in Item second, third and fourth of this my will be sold at public
Sale and the proceeds after paying all my just debts be equally divided
between my four children, Andrew, Joseph W. Garcia, and Sarah Fran-
ces Adams
- Item 6th I hereby constitute and appoint Joseph W. Adams Guardian of the persons
of property of my daughter Sarah Frances until she becomes of age or marries
- Item 7th I hereby constitute and appoint my Sons Andrew and Joseph W. Adams Ex-
ecutors to this my last Will & Testament Anna Adams

Court, as her last Will and Testament freely, voluntarily and without any force or threat
or compulsion or influence whatever that at the time of an instrument giving
said testator was of sound disposing mind and memory that deponent signed said
Will as witness to and subscriber thereto on the 12th day of August 1839 her request in the presence of said
other I wrote to and subscribed thereto before me in open Court this 12th day of August 1839
