

Charles Lloyd's Will - Recorded

Harris County Will Book 2 (1850-1875)

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State of Georgia Harris County
In the name of God Amen We trust that I Charles Lloyd of the State and County aforesaid after having bequeathed my soul to God who gave it and my body to the dust from whence it was taken do now proceed to my worldly concern of which I dispose in the following manner [viz]
All the worldly wealth my Heavenly Father in his providence has seen proper to give I desire after my Decease that it shall be sold at public Sale and the proceeds thereof after my just debts are paid equally divided between the widow of Ezechiel Lloyd my Son for her to have and to hold so long as she lives or Devolving her widowhood then to be Equally divided among my Sons Ezechiel Children And Sarah Hanson my Daughter to have and to hold hers so long as she should live then to go to the Heirs of her body And my Daughter Elvira Formby since my Son John Lloyd and my Daughter Mary Thetford have and to hold so long as she shall live or remain a widow then to be equally divided among the Heirs of her body, I desire that some notes which I now hold against my Son Ezechiel Lloyd and John Lloyd be deducted out of their Part I do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking All other and former wills be made and Time here to fore made in writing Whom I have here and Set my hand and Seal this Sixteenth Day of January Eighteen hundred and fifty four 1854. I do further appoint my Son John Lloyd and Nathan Formby Executors of this my last Will and Testament Signed sealed published and Declared by the said Testator Charles Lloyd as and for his last Will and Testament in the presence of us Who have hereunto signed our names as Witnesses in the presence of the said testator
