said will as a witness in the presence of the Testator and at
his request in the presence of the other witness, and that he saw
Thomas G. Baldwin & John H. G. Brown the other subscribing witness

Item 4th I will and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Hines one cow and calf
one bed & stand and clothing for the bed and five dollars in money moreover the
I will and bequeath the residue of my estate both real & personal here
and every where to my two sons Elias J. Hines and Edward H. Hingle
Hines to be divided as herein after provided I will & bequeath one negro
boy Andrew and one thousand dollars to Elias J. Hines my will

and desire is that that my estate both real & personal be sold
to the highest bidder in the town of Hamilton Harris County
Georgia being duly advertised in terms of law provided my
to be hereinafter appointed should think fit for the best
