

Copy of the Last Will and Testament of Eliza Gopaway

State of Georgia Harris County

In the name of God Amen

I Eliza Gopaway being of sound and disposing mind and memory but knowing the uncertainty of human life and being disposed to make some arrangement as to my property will that a kind Providence has blessed me do make publick and ordain this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore by me made

Item 1st I give and bequeath to my son John Gopaway my boy Horace a workman and the tools of his trade my woman Senny about 54 years old and my boy Henry about twenty four years old one Horse two Cows and Calves and three Geese one bed and Furniture and all my Household and Kitchen furniture except an hermaphrodite bed

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Gopaway one bed and furniture and Two Dollars in money

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my son Charles Gopaway ten Dollars in money
