State of Georgia } I, Gabriel Mop of the aforesaid County and State
Harris County } being of sound and disposing mind and memory and
being disposed to settle my worldly affairs, do make this my Last-Will
and Testament-

1st Item: I hereby require that all my just debts be paid by my executor hereinafter
named-

2nd Item: I give and bequeath all the rest of my estate to my Father Henry E. Mop. and
3rd Item: He hereby constitute and appoint my father Henry E. Mop his executor
to this my Last-Will and Testament with full power to carry out this
Will in any way that he may deem proper without any order from
the Court-
