

## Last will &amp; testament of Henry J. Robinson dec'dd Records

State of Georgia } I Henry J. Robinson of the state of Fla.  
Harris County } county of Jackson, being in a low state of  
health, but of a sound and disposing mind and memory,  
believing it more than probable that I may soon depart  
this life, deem it right and proper, both as respects my family  
and myself that I should make a disposition of the property  
with which a kind Providence has blessed me, I do therefore  
make this my last will & testament, hereby revoking and annulling  
all others, by me heretofore made,

1st { I desire and direct that my body be buried in a  
decent and Christian like manner, suitable to my circumstances  
and condition in life. My soul I trust shall return to rest  
with God who gave it, as I hope for salvation through the  
merits and atonement of The blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

2nd { I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without  
delay, by my executors herein after named and appointed

3rd { I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Saphronia A.  
Robinson one half of my entire estate in fee simple,  
consisting of my residence in Jackson county State of Florida  
lying near the village of Greenwood, containing five acres  
of land more or less, with all its appertinances, and all  
my money, notes and accounts, stock consisting of one horse,  
cattle, and hogs, one buggy and cart, household and kitchen  
furniture, and all other property owned or possessed by me  
at the time of my death.

4th { I will and bequeath unto my probable heir or  
issue The other half of my entire estate, as mentioned above,  
and should there be no issue as is above contemplated

I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife above named, my  
entire estate forever in fee simple.

5th { Should the above contemplated heir or heirs, come to mature age,  
I direct that my Executor or Executors do to manage and control,  
that portion of my estate given and bequeathed to the said probable  
issue, during the childhood, or minority of said issue, so as to make  
said property most beneficial unto the end intended to be attained.

6th { I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Saphronia  
A. Robinson, and James A. Robinson, my beloved brother,  
Executors and Executor of this my last will and Testament

said county and state and after being sworn says, that he saw  
the said Henry J. Robinson sign seal publish and declare  
the said paper writing now presented in open court dated Sep  
6<sup>th</sup> 1866 as his last will and testament, freely, voluntarily of  
his own accord without any compulsion, or any undue influence  
whatsoever - that at the time of the execution of said will, said testator  
was of sound disposing mind & memory - that deponent signed  
said will as a witness in the presence of the Testator and at  
his request in the presence of the other witnesses, and that he saw  
Thomas G. Baldwin & John H. G. Cannon the other subscribing witnesses  
sign said will in the presence of the testator and at his request  
sworn to & subscribed  
before me in open court

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay  
by my executors hereinafter appointed as I am unwilling my creditors  
should be delayed in their rights

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I will and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Tucker formerly  
Elizabeth Hines 5 dollars no more nor less

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I will and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Hines one cow and calf  
one bed & steel and clothing for the bed and five dollars in money no more nor less

Item 5 I will and bequeath the residue of my estate both real & personal here  
and every where to my two sons Elias D. Hines and Edward D. Hines

Hines to be divided as hereinafter provided I will & bequeath one negro  
boy Andrew and one ~~negro~~ (1850-1875)

and desire is that ~~both~~ both real & personal be sold  
to the highest bidder in the town of Hamilton Harris County  
Georgia being duly advertised in terms of law provided my  
to be hereinafter appointed should think it best to
