

Georgia November 3 In the Name of God I Name Hugh Horn of the County aforesaid being of sound & disposing mind and memory being desirous to settle my Mortality Affairs while I have Strength So to do do make and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made And first Commit myself to God who graciously unites my body I desire to be buried where ever my memory may be Proper leaving my Mortality Estate I leave as of follows

- I desire my just debts paid
- I will to my dear wife Nancy my lot of land I now reside by for an during her life and after her death said land to Isla Anna Equally dividing among all my Children & to give to my said wife one male cattle my cows & heifers except what I shall hereafter give to my two children William and George Saria Stock to be sold at her death and to be apportioned as the other I will give to Mary Williams the Cow & Calf and furniture and to Thomas Horn I give one Horse & bridle saddle and one team and I will give one Horse & bridle and saddle Anna Horn I give to Jane Horn I give one Cow & calf and bed furniture and to Hugh Horn I give one Horse & bridle & saddle and all the above Property I will give to my said Children above named and I give to William Horn one Horse or mule or other Animal I will give to George Horn Doggoos and also 4 feet long & gamine and after the death of my said wife I will leave everything that is remaining sold and to be equally divided between all my heirs and heirs apparent etc If William my Executor dies my last will Testament and I give to Martha & William one Cow & calf 1 feet long & gamine I instruct them of the said Saria Hugh Horn to this my wife Consenting of the foregoing Schedule of Paper No seal my hand and Seal this 28 day of September 1871
