eternal salvation through the blessed Lord Jesus Christ whose
whose Religion I have professed and as I humbly trust enjoyed for
Item second I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
with out delay by my executors here after named and I am unwilling
my creditors should be delayed of their rights especially as there is
no necessity for delay
Item third I desire that all of the property be left to either for the
support of my wife and children till my present friends
Item fourth I desire that if my dear beloved wife Jane should
die or die that all of my property should be equally divided bet
wixt my children to wit Frathle Weston Mariana Ann and Sarah and
Sister Weston Martha & Sis'ter Cecilia I next Clansa & next Mary the
next Elizabeth & next Harriet & next Anna if my wife should have
either child in a proper time & holding than an equal share with
the balance of my dear beloved wife Jane provided she shall live
and provide either of my children Shula Mary or because of
age they shall as they shall be of age draw out their share
of property from my estate since the balance shall be left to gather more
when until one of them gets them Seven Pounds that is to say
wife Jane do not draw a six pence of either than the above
equal distribution between her and each of the children
Item fifth I constitute and appoint my worthy friend John
Grubbs to this my last will and Testament this twelfth of Nov

last will and Testament in the presence of us the subscribers who
subscribers our names here to be the witness of said Testament
of each other this 12th day of November 1851
