Morris County } I Sonora Pratt of said State
and County being of advanced
age and knowing that I must shortly depart
this life I give it right and proper to be
disposed of by my family and myself that I should
make a disposition of the Property with which I have
been provided by the Providence of God with as few
persons as possible and I have made
this my Last Will and Testament, hereby bequeathing
all and every thing I own by me

Item 1st

I Give and direct and my Body be buried
in a decent and Christian like Manner Suitable
to Circumstances and Conditions in life my Soul
I Trust shall Return to rest with God who
gave it and I hope Eternal Salvation through
the Merits and Atonement of the blessed Lord and
Savior Jesus Christ when I shall appear before
God and I humbly Trust to enjoy for thirty five years
I desire that all my Just debts be paid without delay
by Executors hereinafter appointed and I am
unwilling my Executors should be delayed their
right therefor as there is no necessity for delay

Item 2nd

I Give and bequeath Six in Number
NAMES as following Mrs. J. Pratt Morris E.
James M. Fitcher, John F. Henry Robert Pratt all
Heirs of James M. Pratt and Maria C. Pratt
for the Love and affection I have for them
I have bequeathed Dollars for the Express purpose
to Educate them not subject to any thing else
but for their Education and I appoint J. M.
Pratt their Guardian to apply that money to use
after use but for their Education and I appoint
Jas. M. Pratt my Executor to carry out the
balance of my will and equal distribution of all
my other Property and also amongst my other heirs
Simeon Seal Adeline and Pauline by Sonora Pratt
as his Last Will and Testament in presence of
the Subscribers who Subscribed our Names hereunto
in the presence of said Testator at his Special
request and presence of each other April 11th 1859
