

Copy of the Last Will and Testament of Martha Miller

State of Georgia } In the name of God Amen
Harris County } I Martha Miller of said State and County
being of advanced age, and knowing that I must shortly die, do
therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
others heretofore made by me

- Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and chris-
tian like manner
- Item 2nd I wish all my just debts paid out of any monies belonging to my Estate
- Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto my Son in Law Henry Gibbons Two hun-
dred and thirty Dollars
- Item 4th I give and bequeath to my Son in Law James Fuller One hundred
Dollars
- Item 5th I give and bequeath to my Son in Law Larkin Brantley One hundred
Dollars
- Item 6th I give and bequeath to my Son in Law John Sholars One hundred
Dollars
- Item 7th I give and bequeath to my Son in Law William F. Webster Two hundred
and thirty Dollars
- Item 8th I give and bequeath to my Son Dennis Miller in trust for my
Daughter Sarah Jane Dunn wife Harrison K Dunn, and at her
death to her then living children Ninety Dollars free from the
debts or liabilities or contracts of her present or future Husband
to be controlled by the said Dennis Miller trustee as aforesaid
as he may think best to meet the necessities and wants of my said
Daughter Sarah Jane Dunn; and if there should be any money
remaining in the hands of the said Dennis Miller as aforesaid
at the death of my said Daughter Sarah Jane Dunn then to
her children
- Item 9th I give and bequeath to my Son in Law Francis M. Ligon Two
hundred and thirty Dollars also one Feather Bed Bedstead and Furniture
- Item 10th The Balance of my Estate I give and bequeath to my three Sons
to wit: Dennis Miller Joseph Miller and Benjamin Miller
to be equally divided between them
- Item 11th I hereby appoint my Sons Dennis Miller and Joseph Miller
my Executors, with power to carry out the same without the
expense of Letters Testamentary, as all my Children are of
age to take Receipt for the same and have them Recorded
as the Law directs. This 7th day of September 1856
