in a Red of Affliction but in my Reason and knowing that I
must depart this World like all Saime time sooner or later deem it Right
and Proper both as respects my self my Parents & Sister that I should
make a distribution of the Property which a kind Providence has ble
sed me with do therefore make this my last will and Testament hereby
Revolling at other here to fore made by me

- 1st Item I desire and direct that my Body be Buried in a decent
and Christian like manner suitable to my Circumstances and Condi
tion in life my soul I trust shall returne to rest with Gods who for it
- 2^d Item I desire and request that all my just debts be Paid without
delay by my Executors herein after appointed as I am unwilling
my Creditors should be detur'd in their Rights
- 3^d Item I give Request unto, devise to my beloved Father Samuel
Brutt Sen and Mother Sarah Brutt his wife and my beloved
Sister Jerusha Brutt my Interest which is one half of Lot of Land
No 44 forty four in 6th district of or originally Joseph now Harbors
County containing two thousand two & a half acres about one hundred &
Twenty five of which are cleared and in Cultivation with all the Rights
Members and appertanances to Saide Lot of Land in any wise belonging
to gether with all my Crop of the Present year and also the Plantation
Inventals I also give unto hereunto to my beloved Parents and Sister
as before stated my Interest which is one half of two Horses and one mare
also my Interest which is one half of all the Cattle & Hogs and Stock
of every description also my Interest which is one half of the following
named Negroes (W^o) one man by name of Isham about Twenty three
Years of age Eunice a woman about the same age Emily a woman
about Twenty one also my Interest in which is one half of one wagon
and one gear also one black also my Interest in the House Hold and
Hutchin Furniture also my Interest which is one half one note on James
P Wentcherson for about fifty four Dollars also one note on Thomas
J. Harris for about seven Dollars together with all my accounts
that may be found in my Papers the before stated property all of which
shall be and belong to my beloved Parents and Sister jointly to be
used for their own Benefit and maintenance during the natural
lifetime of the Saide Parents Provided that the Saide Sister Jerusha Brutt
shall survive the Saide Parents and at the death of Saide Parents
all the before stated property with the Increase thereof shall belong to
the before stated Jerusha Brutt and her Heires for ever to dispose
of in any way they may think Proper & Provide However that
the Saide Sister Jerusha Brutt should Mary be born the death of
Saide Parents then and in that Case she is hereby authorized and
and at the time to draw out & take in to Possession one third of the
above said property as the share of Saide Parents & her share
I give the same to receive the other two thirds left in the hands of
Parents which Property shall be and belong to her the Jerusha and
her Heires for ever and Provide & further that the the Saide Jerusha Brutt
shall not Survive her Parents yet may have bodily Bless than and that
Case though the same being of her Body shall have her Interest in said
estate for ever 4th Item I hereby constitute and appoint my
worthy friends Nicholas Wentcherson and Susan & her Executors
of my last will and Testament this 13th day of October 1757
