

The Last-Will & Testament of Sandy T. Johnson and Reciting
the State of Alabama I Sandy T. Johnson of the aforesaid State
Tallapoosa County & County, being conscious of my approaching
death & being of sound mind & memory, thinking that
it is appointed for all men to die do make this my last
will & Testament

First of all I recommend my soul to God who gave it
& my body I desire to be decently buried & as respects such
worldly property where with it has pleased God to bless me
with in this world I have and will dispose of in the following
manner viz

First- I have given to my oldest son Alexander N Johnson a negro girl
Sarah about fourteen years old when given to him also another
property given to him all valued when given to him at six
hundred Dollars

Secondly I now give to my second child viz And Jane Johnson
& Negro boy called Edmund about eleven years old also a barrel
more about three years old called Fannie my best negro & Harness
one hided cow & other articles known by the family as her
all of the bed & bed clothing & box bed & chest & Glassware
as she may claim as having his let her take them also I give
her one half of all the silver & copper & Glassware & two pieces
of crockery which to be chosen by her self the above specified
property I value to be at six hundred dollars as being
deserving of making all my children equal in property now I also
give to her And Jane Johnson a certain nego girl called Mary Ann
sever years old I give said negro to And Jane to be hers
for lifetime & at her death I wish said girl Mary Ann & her
increase if any sold & the proceeds equally divided amongst her
And brothers & sisters or their legal heirs and give to her provi-
sions to do her & her stock for one year after my effects may be divide
d amongst my children said provisions to be set apart to her
by the commissioners that may be appointed to appraise my
property that I may have to be appraised and allotted to
each of my children now being

Thirdly I have given to Thomas H. Johnson my son a negro girl
Daphne about thirty years old when given also other property
valued to him when given at seven hundred & fifty
dollars

Fourthly I have given to my daughter Martha C. Partridge a negro
girl Charney some eight years old when given to her other
property all valued when given to her at six hundred
dollars

Fifthly I have given to my son George Johnson a negro boy & one
about fourteen years old when given & other property all
valued when given at one thousand & fifty dollars

Sixthly I have given to my daughter Margaret R Brooks a negro
girl Harriett about twelve years old when given & other property
all valued when given to her at eight hundred & fifty dollars

Seventhly I have given to my daughter Mary & George a negro boy
about three years old when given at five hundred dollars

Eighthly

I have given to my son William S. Johnson a negro boy, Jerry about fifteen years old when given also other property, value where given at eleven hundred Dollars

Ninthly

I do now give unto my son Erasmus S. Johnson a negro boy called Emmanuel about two years old also a gray mare about six years old & my watch also I give to him one half of all the cutlery bedding & Glass ware that may be yours at my death also I give to him a bed sheet & beds & bed clothes sufficient to fit it up to be selected for him by his sister all valued to him at seven hundred Dollars

Tenthly

I do give to John C. Partridge my Grand son one hundred Dollars in money to be lent out at interest & kept so until he receives twenty-one years old

Eleventhly

I do request & desire that all the negroes that I may own at my death be appraised by Commissioners appointed by the Court of Probate & divided equally or as near as can be amongst my seven children now living & also beneath the minor children of Thos H. Johnson deceased. Said negroes received their lawful share of my estate in money & do further appoint Henry Brooks as trustee for the minor children of Thos H. Johnson deceased to take charge of the effects that may be going to the said minors & to invest said effects in lands or in bonds but should said lands fail & do not wish said trustees to be held responsible for them & if said trustees think it necessary for the benefit of the said minors. I do appoint Alexander A. Johnson as trustee for the minor children of Henry S. Johnson deceased with all the restrictions and privileges given to him among the trustees of the minors of Thos H. Johnson deceased & do request that all my just debts be paid out of the effects in hand or the first got in hand And do request that my land and the stock & all the other property not enumerated in this instrument be sold and there's want all my children to have an equal share of my estate either in money or property & if any should get more than an equal share in property they must pay back in money to the estate that amount due from them to make all receive the same amount either in money or property & do request & desire that all the negroes that I may own at my death be appraised by Commissioners appointed by the Court of Probate & divided equally or as near as can be amongst my seven children now having & I do bequeath to Henry S. & Thos H. Johnson my poor children to give their share of my estate in money & in property to their wives as trustee for the minor children of Thos H. Johnson to take charge of the effects that may be going to said minors to invest said effects in lands or in bonds but should said lands fail do not wish said trustees to be held responsible for them if necessary I do request that said trustees

pay out the interest on said minors estates annually for
the benefit of said minors also I do appoint Thos T Johnson
as trustee of the minors of A. S. Johnson deceased with the
same restrictions & privileges as given the trustee for Thos T Johnson
Johnson deceased minors & do request that all my just debts be
paid out of effects on hand I do request that my land & all the
stock & all other property not enumerated in this instrument
be sold and then I want all my children to have an equal
share of my estate either in property or money & if any should
get more than an equal share in property they must pay back in
money to the rest that amount due from them to make
all receive the same amount either in money or property
I do ordain constitute & appoint Henry Brooks as Executor to this
my last will & testament and before said Executor gets any
amount of money on hand he shall set all the legatees at
the amount and hands & purpose to pay over to them their
proportion & if they are of age & if they refuse to receive the money
& if there be money after that go toward the said executor should
not be responsible for it - But he must not receive money
that are not at the time of receiving the
same

sixteenth day of October AD one thousand eight hundred
and sixteen years.
