and all the farming utensils Except part of Plow
and gear with a half Interest in the Wagon one
New Name Muley another Calf one matrike
two Quills one Bed Stegs one Counterpane two
Shirts one Pillow three Chairs one Table one
half of the Hogs that may be on the Place at my
Death and one half of my Port of the Crop
that may be on the Place when I die or any thing
that may be sold there for which the Crop has sold
Item 2d I give and bequeath unto my Beloved
Daughter Maria Mason one Male Name
giving one set of Plow gear one half Interest in
the Wagon one half the Hogs that may be on the place
at my death one half of my Port of the Crop that
may be on the Place at my death or one half
of the Money that may be on hand for which
the Crop has sold one Table three Chairs one
Large Pot & Item 3. I give and bequeath
unto my Grand Daughter Margaret Ann
Mason one Cow & calf Name be Item 4th
I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter
Martha Elizabeth Mason one Cow & calf
Item 5. I after the above Distribution I do my
say this will and devise that from any Property
Remaining of any that the Children of my Son
Sham Phillips Decedent shall have one dollar
Item 6th It is further my will and desire
that three Children of my Son Samuel Phillips
Decedent shall have one dollar Item 7th It is
further my will and desire that my Son
Phillip shall have one dollar Item 8th
It is further my will and desire that my Son
Moses Phillips shall have one dollar Item 9th
It is further my will and desire that my
Son Samuel Phillips shall have one dollar Item 10th
It is further my will and desire that the Children
of my Daughter Billy Garrison Decedent shall
have one dollar Item 11th It is further
my will and desire that the Children
my Daughter Margaret Decedent
shall have one dollar Item 12th
