

My Last Will and Testiment of Sarah Phillips

one p[er]f[ec]t in body but [some] of mind and intellect
and knowing I may die before this my last will and testiment
is made I hereby declareing we annesse all others
namely No. 1 which is my Will and choose that after
my just debts (if any) be paid what remains shall
be divided as follows Item 1st of gear and
equu[m]ath unto my beloved daughter Sarah or
Martha V Jackson to certain place named Scott
and all the property unlesed except gears of
gear worth a half Interest in the Wagon and
Cow named Hughey another Calf the matrik
Sheep two one lamb Sheep one Counterfeid Fox
Sheep one Peacock thru chairs one Oak one
half of the log that may be on the place at my
decease and one half of my Port of the Crop
that may be on the place wherein I live or any other
place may be or in the place wherein I die or any other
Item 2d I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Daughter Anna Pearson one Mule named
Ginger one set of Hors[e] gear one half Interest in
the Wagon one half the sheep that may be on the place
at my death one half of my Port of the Crop that
may be on the place at my death or on back
of the meadow that may be on farm for which
the Cow Sack one Table thru Chair & one
Large Pot Item 3. I give and bequeath
unto my Grand Daughter Margaret Ann
Pearson one Cow & Calf named Item 4th
I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter
Martha Elizabeth Pearson the Cow Lucy & Calf
Item 5th after the above distribution to my
pay this will and desire that from any Proprietary
hereafter of any that they shall have at my son
Samuel Phillips Deceased Shall have one dollar
Item 6th In further my will and desire
that when Children of my Son Samuel Phillips
Deceased Shall have one dollar Item 7th
from this my will and desire that my Son
Philip Phillips have one dollar Item 8th
In further my will and desire that my Son
Mark Phillips shall have one dollar Item 9th
it is further my will and desire that my
Son Samuel Phillips have one dollar Item 10th
it is further my will and desire that the children
of my Granddaughter Lucy Garrison shall have
more one dollar Item 11th it is further
my will and desire that my Granddaughter
my Daughter Margaret shall have
shall have one dollar or less than
further my will and desire
