

# Vincent A Hill Will

State of Georgia  
Harris County<sup>3</sup> I Vincent A Hill of the State  
of Harris County<sup>3</sup> and County aforesaid being in full  
health but of sounds mind feel it my duty to make this my last  
in Order, that I may direct how my Estate shall be Managed  
and disposed of when I shall be called from time to eternity,  
 1<sup>st</sup> I command my soul to God who gave it and look forward  
to the resurrection for a reunion of soul & body and a blessed immortality  
 2<sup>nd</sup> I wish all my just debts settled and all my unsettled business  
settled up, after which I wish my whole estate both real & personal  
personal to be managed and finally disposed of in the following  
Manner, viz I ordain and direct that my property shall all  
be kept together and Managed as Common Stock for the education  
of my children and support of my family For this purpose I  
appoint my wife Mariah <sup>to</sup> be my Executrix to whom I grant  
the entire Control and direction of all my estate for the support  
and Maintenance of herself, and my children during her lifetime or  
Widowhood. I further Grant my wife the privilege if any  
of my children should become of age or marry during her lifetime  
or Widownhood, the power to give off to them such property and  
such amount as she may deem proper and prudent exercising her  
own discretion in no case however to exceed their portion of property  
on an equal division of my whole estate, on the death of my wife  
I direct that my whole estate, real and personal to be equally  
divided among my children Viz Rosaline Antine, Sophie Howell  
Jennett, Susannah, Mary Ann Joanna, Rebecca Ann, and if  
my wife should have a living child within nine months after my  
death I wish it to be placed on an equal footing with my other  
children, with reference to my estate deducting whatever amount any  
of them may have previously received so as to make them all equal  
on a final division But if my wife should marry after my death  
in that case I direct that my estate should be equally divided  
between her (she to have a child part) and my three living children  
deducting as aforesaid any portion which may have been given  
off to any of the children from the amount which they then receive.

In witness of the above, I Vincent A Hill do sign the foregoing  
as my last will and testament this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1853,
