make & publish this my last will & testament for
revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore
made. I first bequeath my soul to God &
give it to my body, I desire to be buried
in the family burial ground at my age &
to my worldly estate that has not yet been
disposed of I will dispose of as follows
that Lucy C. Maguire I give to her & her heirs
and good friends I bid & I seal

Hart County Wills (1847-1862)

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I solemnly for said bid out of my estate. I desire that
 my last of said that I bet some Personal Bobs be sold &
 the whole that is belonging to me consisting of Cows,
 Hogs & Sheep & also my Farming Tools together
 with my household & kitchen furniture together with all
 the effects that is belonging to my said estate be sold
 after my death & I will that the proceeds of such
 said & equally divided into four shares to gether with
 whatever amount ^{may} be found in my possession after
 the said day. I will give the first share to my
 third, I will give my share to my nephew Mr. Brody, one
 fourth part of the amount. I will to my eldest
 daughter Ann Robuck, one fourth part amount above
 named. I will give my eldest daughter Alice E. Thornton
 one fourth part of the amount. 6th I will give to my grand-
 daughter Lucy C. Magee the remaining fourth share.
 I do also appoint my son Jephtha W. Brody to act as
 executor of the my last will & testament in witness
 whereof I the said Ann Gors to this my will, request-
 ing of the foregoing sheet of paper to deal this
 15th day of Oct 1860.

 of sound & disposing mind
