planting to my beloved wife the farming utensils and to belonging
to said plantation, that is the place where I now live,
also the stock of every kind pertaining to said farm or in
any way belonging to me, also all my household & kitchen
furniture of every description. 5th Item. It is my will & desire
at the death of my beloved wife, that all the proceeds & re-
mainder of my estate in her hands be equally divided be-
tween my two sons viz. Mark & Jeff. 6th Item. I hereby
constitute my beloved wife, Lucy Ann executrix of this my
