

Will of Alis Ridley deceased

I Alis Ridley of the County and State aforesaid being of sound mind disposing mind and memory and coming to mind the uncertainty of life deem it right and proper both as regards myself and family that I make a disposition of the property I possess do make declare and publish this my last will and testament

I Give 1st I direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner and all my just debts be paid Item 2nd I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha Emmerline Ridley during her natural life the control of my household and kitchen furniture and all the live stock also one large cattle

Item 3rd And at her death to be divided equally between my four daughters namely Sophronia B. Gustin Marshall & Elizabeth P. Ridley and Abigail Lee Ridley

Item 4th I further most will and bequeath unto my two sons Warren A. & William D. Ridley at my death my blacksmith tools gun thrust saw mill and farming tools weapons

Item 5th I constitute nominate and appoint my two sons Warren A. & William D. Ridley my sole Executors of this my last will and testament I signed my hand & seal
