

Will of Geo. H. Glenn. Decd

Georgia  I George H. Glenn of said County Heard County being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last will and testament

I have first: I give bequeath and devise to my mother Elizabeth S. Glenn all of my money that I may have

Item Second: I give bequeath and devise to my nephews T. H. Burpee Samuel C. Burpee and George T. Burpee the following property to wit. All of my notes and perishable property divided between themselves

Item Third I give bequeath and devise to my Nieces Jennie Burpee and O. Burpee the following property to wit My entire interest in the Atlanta and West Point Rail road Consisting of Ten thousand dollars worth of stock divided between the two

Item fourth I give bequeath and devise to my sister Ed Cook the following property to wit One hundred acres of land off of lot no. 20 in Sec 100 situated acres of **Heard County Wills 1894-1900** and to hold the whole of www.georgiapioneers.com

Item fifth I give bequeath and devise to my nephew William Glenn the following property to wit One hundred acres of land off of fraction 7, 7 1/2 to 75 to hold and to hold as he provides, it is claimed by him in person within one year after my death and if such claim is not so made said land as to be the property of my sister Ed Cook

Item Sixth I give bequeath and devise to my sister Ed Burpee the following property to wit One thousand dollars worth of stock in the Bank of Pocomoke (Pocomoke Ala)

Item Seventh I hereby constitute and appoint my Nephews T. H. Burpee Samuel C. Burpee and George T. Burpee executors of this my last will and testament. This the 21 day of Feb 1893
