Item 3rd, To my son J. M. Daniel, the house and lot I now occupy and known as my present residence containing two acres more or less and bounded on the north by Creek leading from the said place to the Franklin bridge, south by Chattahoochee river, on the east by public street leading from the Court house square in said County South via J. M. Buttrills Grimes place South by lot of Frank A. Loflin and West by lands of J. M. Daniel this place is in the town of Franklin Square and beyond.

Item 4th I will all the residue of my estate (except this portion I have this day made deeds to) to my two daughters Josie Hendrick and Helen Hendrick of whatsoever kind it may consist, whether real or personal property, money, notes and accounts or choses in action or anything else of value to my said son J. M. Daniel.

Item 5th, I bequeath nothing in this will to the heirs of my son J. M. Daniel died for the reason I consider that during his lifetime he was a sufficient property owner and effects as would amount in value to one fourth of my estate.

Item 6th I bequeath nothing in this will to either of two daughters Josie Hendrick and Helen Hendrick for the reason I heretofore gave to each of them and their husbands A. H. Hendrick and Hugh L. Hendrick respectively sufficient property, money and effects including that which I have this day conveyed to each of them by deed as would amount in value to one fourth of my estate, each one getting one fourth.

Item 7th, I hereby appoint my son J. M. Daniel executor to this my last will and testament and release him from making any appraisement of my estate and from making annual returns to the Court of Ordinary and he is empowered and he is authorized to compromise on settle any and all claims for or against my estate in such manner as he may think best without any order from said Court of Ordinary, and for this purpose he is empowered to sell any of my property real or personal at private or public sale as he thinks best without any order from the Court of Ordinary and to make deeds and acquittances to the same in testimony whereof I have hereunto
