It is my desire that there be no lawsuit over my estate.
All of which on the fifth day after Minion Adams' death
was reduced to writing and signed by me at the request
of Warren Adams and J. Jackson selected by the next
of kin to administer on said Minion's estate given
under our hands this February 12th 1894
