Will of Mordicai Edwards Deceased

State of Georgia Troup County

Last will and testament of Mordicai Edwards
Mordicai Edwards of the County of Heard said State
being of sound mind and memory, deem it right
and proper to dispose of the property with which
a kind providence has blessed me.

I desire my just debts be paid including my bur-
ial expenses.

I will and bequeath unto my blood niece and
step daughter Eugenia Indiana Vickers wife of Charles
S. Vickers of Troup County one half of all my household
and kitchen furniture except one bed and bedding
given to Florence Eldalia Vickers

I also give and bequeath to my said niece
and step daughter Eugenia Indiana Vickers one hun-
dred and sixty acres of land more or less in the Liberty
hill district of Heard County Georgia being parts of lots
(as remembered) 27 & 28 and known as the Cassel
place bounded north by lands of W. Owensby on South by
lands of said Eugenia Indiana Vickers and J. S. Edwards
East by lands of Mrs. Nancy Owensby and West by
Wilson and others. I also give and bequeath to my
said niece and step daughter the said Eugenia Indiana
Vickers all of her indebtedness to me of every kind and
amount up to this date I do further give and
bequeath unto my said niece and step daughter the
said Eugenia Indiana Vickers one third interest in the
remainder of all my real and personal estate of every
kind with eight hundred acres in more or less
of land at Subsequent Part of this will my son's name
also except one Piano fork.

I give and bequeath to my niece Cynthia Edwards

Owensby of Heard County one third interest in my home place in Heard and Grant Counties containing about five hundred and twenty two acres of land and bounded on North by Issiah Partidge and others, South by Mrs Caroline Edmonds Motley and others, East by S. H. O'Connell and West by M. H. Kirby and others. I also give and bequeath to my said niece Cynthia Elizabeth Owensby one half interest in all my household and kitchen furniture except one bed and bedding and one Piano for otherwise disposed of by this will. I also give and bequeath to my said niece the said Cynthia Elizabeth Owensby one third interest in all my real and personal property not otherwise disposed of in this will.

I give and bequeath to William Bennett one of my minor children of the said Anna Belle Morgan one share and share alike one third interest in my home place described in item 4 - and also one third interest in my personalty not otherwise disposed of and I hereby appoint my Executors guardians of said bequest for said minors until the account of each.

6 I will and bequeath to my sisters Caroline Edwards and Stacy Hubbard the sum of eight hundred dollars to be equally divided between them and each of them must be paid out money out of my estate.

7 I will and bequeath to Florence (Edwina) Vickers daughter of my niece Eugenia Indiana Vickers one bed and bedding and Quinns fork and my buggy and harness.

8 I hereby appoint C. Vickers and C. Owensby my Executors to carry out this my last will and testament.
