Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent christian like manner suitable
to my circumstances and condition My Soul I
trust shall return to rest with God who gave it
as I hope for eternal salvation through the blessed
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I
have professed and as I humbly trust enjoyed
Second I desire and direct that all my just
debts be paid without delay by my Executors here-
inafter named as I am unwilling my Creditors sh-
ould be delayed of their rights

Third I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Cynthia O Maugh all my estate both Public real and
private to her own proper use benefit and behoof
forever with full power to dispose of the same
at any time before or at her death as she may
think proper

Fourth I constitute and appoint my beloved wife
Cynthia O Executrix and my worthy friend J P
Campbell Executor to this my last will & Testament
March the 24th 1847
