

Georgia In the name of God Amen
Henry County & I Albritton Warr of the State of
Georgia and County of Henry being
of sound disposing mind and memory, this the
sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord
our thousand eight hundred and forty nine. do
make this my last will & Testament in manner and
form following To-wit,

First - I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife
Priscilla Warr all that tract or parcel of land
belonging to my possession lying North of the path
leading from James McCounes to George T. Sams
together with all the improvements and appertinances
thereto belonging - and the household and kitchen
furniture (on good) feather bed and a good
furniture excepted; I also, further give sixty dollars
in cash to be paid to her annually by my Executors
beginning after my decease and the said sixty dollars
to come equally out of the portion of my
legacies according to the arrangement that I have
made, also one horse to be valued at sixty dollars
also one side Saddle besides a blanket; also one
Buggy - two Cows & calving Ten head of hogs & four
head of sheep - all to be of her own selection
out of my stock provided she does not sell or
give or otherwise dispose of the above named
articles in the above named bequest and in
case she does not sell give or otherwise dispose
of any or either of the above named articles
the right is then in such articles to pass out
of her and to revert to the my Estate in general
and to be equally distributed among my legacies
according to the order that I have before named
but if she keeps them in her own possession she is
to have the full right and title for and during her
natural life time and in case the above articles of
property and money should fail to support my said
beloved Wife Priscilla Warr it is further my Will
and command that my Executors appropriate such
portion of my Estate as will support her comfortably
The above portion of my Estate is intended for
the support & maintenance of my Wife during

her natural life & then revert to my
Estate & be divided as the new and away
my Estate is

Secondly -

It is my Will and I do hereby Will
and direct that all my Estate both real & personal and
mixed, that has not been already disposed of
with the exception of my Books & Cloths and a
good feather bed & bed furniture be sold and
after paying my just debts be divided into
six equal parts,

The first sixth part I Will and bequeath to my
beloved son, Wm. Mara to him and his heirs forever
I also Will and bequeath him my books and
clothes,

The second sixth part, I Will and bequeath to my
daughter Mary Bunn, and her two children Emily and
Bunnell to be divided between the two children Emily &
Bunnell at the death of their mother Mary Bunn
I intend this portion of my Estate for my daughter
& her two children Emily & Bunnell, & not to be subject
to her present nor future husbands debts,

I also hereby appoint my son Wm. Mara as
Trustee, for my beloved daughter Mary Bunn.

The third sixth part, I Will and bequeath to the
Wife of my son Benjamin Mara to have and
to hold during her lifetime & then divided between
all of the Children she has or may have by my
son Benjamin Mara,

The fourth sixth part, I Will and bequeath to my
beloved daughter Elizabeth Caswell, to her and her
heirs forever.

The fifth sixth part, I Will and bequeath to
my beloved daughter Francis Singleton to her
and her heirs forever.

The sixth sixth part, I Will and bequeath
to my beloved son John Mara to him and
his heirs forever.

Lastly, I constitute and appoint my friends David
Daly & Thomas Johnson, both of the Sixth District and
County of Henry & State aforesaid my Executors

of this my last will & Testament revoking all others
before made by me In witness whereof I Allbittain Ward
have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
