mind and memory do make and ordain this to be my
last will and Testament hereby revoking all former
wills

Item 1st My body I wish buried in a decent Christian
like manner my soul I commit to the keeping of my
Gracious Redeemer

Item second I wish my just debts to be paid as soon after
my death as can be done consistent with the interest
of my Estate

Item third I devise that my whole of my Estate after
the payment of debts shall be divided into four Equal
parts one of which (that is one fourth of my Estate
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Eugenia J Sally
and her heirs forever one other fourth of my estate
I give and bequeath to Nathan Sally in trust for
the use and benefit of my Daughter Catharine
Sally and her children said property to be free from
all liability to the debts of the husband of my said
Daughter one other fourth part of my Estate I give
and bequeath to my Grand Children Cornelia A Segar
John T. Segar Mary J Segar & Auden J Segar Ann Segar
the children of my son Dr William Segar
And the other remaining fourth part of my Estate
I give & bequeath to my Grand Children the children
of my son John Segar to them & their heirs

Item forth Before the General division is made
as aforesaid I desire that four of my negroes to wit
Cely. Ned. Parker. & Wade shall be valued and I
hereby give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter
Ann Batey the one fifth of the value of the said
four negroes

In the name of God amen I Elyah Stilwell of the State of Georgia & County of Henry being weak in body, but of perfectly sound disposing mind & memory and taking into consideration the mortality of the body and being disposed to make some disposition of my earthly property do make this my last will and Testament in the manner and form following (to wit) but first of all I resign my soul to God who gave it and my body to the dust to be buried in a christianlike manner at the discretion of my Executors and as to my property in the first place I will and bequeath that all my Just debts be paid and secondly I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Stilwell the plantation whereon I now live during her natural life in the third place I also will and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Stilwell my negro man Ephraim my negro woman Nancy & her child Nancy together with their Increase and all the other property which I may be possessed of at my death during her natural life except such as may be hereafter named.
