Henry County I know all men by these presents that we James Bledsoe Travy & Bledsoe & Lefee Johnson are held and firmly bound unto their Honours the Judges of the Court of Ordinary for said County, & their Successors in office, in the Last & Full Sum of Three Thousand dollars for the payment of which sum to the said Judges and their Successors in office, we bind our Selves, our Heirs Executors & administrators, Jointly & Severally, firmly by sealed with our Seals and dated this fourth day of March 1828.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said James Bledsoe is this day appointed Guardian to Elizabeth Bledsoe & James Bledsoe Children of the said James Bledsoe now if the said James Bledsoe do well and truly demean himself as Guardian aforesaid agreeably to Letters of Guardianship bearing even date herewith & agreeable to Law made and provided in such case the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force & Virtue — Signed sealed and acknowledged in open Court
