Item 6th I give and bequeath unto my sister Ridley

and personal the same to be exempt forever from
from the debts liabilities & disposition of her present
or a future husband and it is my wish and desire
that her husband Turner Evans act as her agent
in the management and control of said property
Lastly I nominate & appoint my friend Francis
E Mansaw Executor of this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking if any all former wills
