appointed unto all men once to die in prospect thereof do make certain
establish and Declare this my last will and Testament in manner
and form following (W3)

First I give and bequeath unto Benjamin Kimbell and John Kimbell
one lot of land lying and being in the second district of Morgan
County known as common four in said district with what I have
heretofore given him the said Benjamin Kimbell

Secondly I give and bequeath to my son Christopher Kimbell
one Cribboard

Item 3 I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my son Gideon Kimbell
who is now dead the sum of five Dollars

Item 4 I give and bequeath unto my three grandsons the heirs
of Thomas Kimbell deceased one hundred and fifty Dollars
which sum is to be equally divided among them

Item 5th I give and bequeath unto my son ~~Robert~~ Kimbell
the sum of five Dollars together with what I have heretofore
given him

Item 6 I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Kimbell
the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars together with
what I have heretofore given him

Item 7 I give and bequeath unto my son David Kimbell the
sum of five Dollars together with what I have heretofore given him

Item 8 Its my will that my Negro man Jerry be sold
at my death at public auction for twelve months credit
small notes and approve security and the money to be applied
to the payment of the above legacies

Item 9 Its my will after all necessary expenses is defrayed that
the remainder of the money be equally divided among the
heirs of my son Gideon Kimbell if any there be

Lastly I nominate and appoint Christopher Kimbell and
David Kimbell Executors of this my last will and Testa-

ment and to carry the several clauses thereof into full
effect and now having fully and finally disposed of all
earthly concerns I consign my body to the grave and my
spirit to the Lord who gave it in testimony whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this the third day
of August Eighteen hundred and thirty eight
