I David McCants of the county & State of said calling to
mind the mortality of the body knowing it is appointed
for all men once to die being in a low state of
Health but of sound and perfect mind and memory.
Blessed be God for the same do make and publish
this my last will and testament in manner and form
following that is to say -
First my will and Desire is that my loving
Wife Elizabeth McCants shall have sixty Dollars in
cash her bed & bed clothing bed stead lot gether so as
to render her comfortable and so much of my
Kitchen furniture as she may think proper to render
her comfortable also my Desire is that my Daughter
Margaret McCants shall have sixty Dollars in cash and
also that my son Eli McCants have my Wagon and
Hornes and all things there unto belonging and
further my Desire is that my Negro boy Jacob be
the property of my Wife Elizabeth and Margaret my
Daughter During their natural Life time and after
their death to become the property of my son Eli
McCants provided he should be the longest lived
and if not to his Heirs if any. as to my Cherokee
Land No. 220 in the ninth Dist Morris County Georgia
and also my Lot of Forty acre Lot lying in twenty
first Dist parlaying. County no. six hundred and twenty
Eight both to be sold at publick. out cry
and the money divided amongst all my Heirs by
equal Division and also all my Horse stock and

Wdets Hogs and sheep to be sold at publick sale
and the proceeds Equally Divided between my heirs in
General after all my just debts is paid and as
to my pension if ever collected to be like wise made
Equally Division of as above

And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint
my son Eli McConato and my son in law Christopher
Wiggers my lawful Executors to this will & Testament
In witness of all of which I the said David McConato have here
unto set my hand & affixed my seal the 30th day October 1836
