arrive at the age of twenty one years. Then so
much of the estate shall be given to them or
within of them as they may marry or arrive
at the age of twenty one years (as can be
conveniently spared at the discretion of my Exec-
utors) and so soon as the youngest child
shall marry or arrive at the age of twenty
one years I will and direct that all of my
Estate, Real & personal be sold at public sale
and the sum arising from such sale together
with the amount which may be given to within
of the Children before such sale, when thrown
together, I will, and order, to be distributed in
the following manner that is to say (I give
and bequeath unto my loving wife, Priscilla
Richardson one third thereof for ever and the
balance to be equally divided and distributed)
