Item^{3d} I give and bequeath to my loving wife Lucy
Law five thousand dollars to be paid to her as follows
to wit two negroes viz one a man by the name of
Ephraim and one girl by the name of Hannah
at one thousand dollars and that tract of Land
which I now own containing one hundred and
twenty four ^{ta half} acres of land more or less lying and
being in the seventh(7) district of said county & being
the western part of lot of Land number one hundred
and fifty Six (156) in said district and county aforesaid
at seven hundred dollars the remainder say three
thousand three hundred dollars to be paid in cash
so soon as my executors can raise it out of my estate
I also give and bequeath to my loving wife Lucy Law
all the provisions that I have on hand at my death
I also bind to my loving wife Lucy Law my house and
lot where I now live in the Town of McFarland together
with all the household furniture also my two
horses & waggon and oxen & cart and all my stock of
hogs and cattle during her natural life or widowhood
at her death or inter marriage said house and lot
and furniture and said horses & waggon cart & oxen
& slaves frogs and cattle to be sold and the proceeds
to be equally divided between my loving wife Lucy Law
my son John H Law my daughter Abby Lunsford
my son James H Law and my Daughter Lucy H
Law and if my wife Lucy Law dies to be equally
divided between my four children

Item^{4d} I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy
H Law five thousand dollars to be paid ~~the~~
dollars to wit three thousand six hundred

Martha her child and ~~Bridy~~ a girl molatto at
 twenty hundred dollars the balance say thirty eight
 hundred dollars to be paid to her or her Guardian
 in cash so soon as my executors can conveniently have
 it out of my estate - the reason I have not given
 in this my last will and testament to my son John H.
 Low and my daughter Aphyer Brumshaw and my
 son James H. Low the same amount that I have
 given to my living wife Lucy Low and my daughter
 Lucy & Low is that I have given them the same am-
 ount (of five thousand dollars) out of my estate pre-
 cious to my memory this my last will and Testament
 I give the whole of my property not otherwise dispo-
 sed of in this my will both real and personal to be
 sold and after paying my ^{but} debts and the legacies
 hereinafter named to be equally divided between my
 living wife Lucy Low my son John H. Low
 my daughter Aphyer Brumshaw my son James H.
 Low and my daughter Lucy & Low

I further nominate and appoint my living wife Lucy
 & Low my executrix and my son John H. Low
 my executor to attend to this my last will and
 testament signed sealed and published in presence of
 the testator at his request this the third day of May
 one thousand eight hundred and forty one - the
 words number 8 Waggon on the first page intermixed
 before signature
