to my circumstances and condition -
Item Second.

I desire and direct that all my just
be paid by my Executor & Executrix herein after named -
Item Third.

I give and devise to my beloved wife Jane
Barnes the tract of land wherein I now live containing (350) three hundred and fifty acres more or less
lying in the twelfth district of the County and State
abovesaid with all the rights appurtenances of
said tract of land in any wise appertaining or
belonging to her during her natural life or widowhood -
Item Fourth.

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
for and during her natural life or widowhood
my negro man named George about nineteen years
of age, my negro woman Adelice about twenty years
of age and her five children Sarah a girl about ten
years old Lewis a boy about eight years old Malissa
a girl six years old Joseph a boy two years old
Alice a girl about two months old - in case she
marries or dies the before named property shall revert
to my Estate -
Item Fifth -

Now should the boy George prove refractory
and disobedient my Executor and Executrix may
dispose of him as they may think best either by
sale or otherwise -
Item Sixth -

I constitute and appoint my beloved wife
Jane Executive my worthy friend C. W. Smith Executor to this
my last Will & Testament July 11th 1859
