First I commend my soul into the hands of my Creator who gave it. As to such worldly Estate ~~or~~ ^{then with it} hath pleased God to entrust me, I dispose of the same as followeth.

First. I wish that all my just debts to be paid at my death.

2nd I give unto my beloved wife Sarah Johnson during Widowhood or life time the following property ^{to} be, a man about thirty years of age and Emily a ^{negr.} girl, one Bed & furniture, two Tables, half a dozen Chairs good & Kitchen furniture, and such other things as are necessary for house keeping Two Cows & Calf, one pair plough Gear and plow and my wish is that she is to keep her house if she will live on it, and to cultivate the land if not I wish it sold, and I wish her to have one years support. All of the above property to be given up to be divided amongst my Children at her death or intermarriage. The negros as above named not to be taken out of the State

3rd I wish my wife to have a horse & Buggy and fore him to do as she pleases with them

4th I wish my grand Son John P. Johnson to have a negr Boy Daniel about seven or eight years old & I wish John H. Johnson to act as guardian for the said John P. Johnson. also I wish him to act as Guardian for Peck's Children & to give each one his part as soon as they become of age or marry.

5th My wish is that Thomas D Johnson Son H Johnson A.C. Johnson. James D Johnson, Eliza Jones Martha Peck, their children all to have as much of my estate as will make them equal with my daughter Nancy Hudson & Catherine. I Smith have received from me in my life

10th My wish is that Mary Johnsons Children have the
same as Thomas. G. Johnsons Children

11th I wish James J. Johnson to act as guardian for them

12th My will and wish is that that after all of
the above named Children have been made
equal with my daughter Nancy Hudson
and Catherine A. Smith which was three hundred
and fifty dollars each; the balance of my estate
if any left to be equally divided amongst all
of ~~the~~ Children including Nancy Hudson
Catherine A. Smith and take the same
course as the other property

Know all men by these presents that I Harry Gallman of the State of New York aforesaid being of sound age and in a feeble state of health but of sound mind and memory and knowing that according to the common course of Nature I must shortly depart from this world deem it right and proper both as respects myself and family that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me I therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all others heretofore made by me

Item 1st I will that is to say First after all my lawful debts are paid are discharged the residue of my Estate both Real and Personal I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Catharine Gallman during her natural life for the purpose of maintaining and supporting my minor children and at her death I advise that the balance of property that may be left at her death be divided equally among my several children and I deem this disposition of my estate to be equitable and just as my older children have been raised out of the property belonging to my estate and I deem it right and proper that the younger children should be raised and educated before a division of my property shall be made I hereby make constitute and appoint my wife Catharine Gallman my executor to carry into effect this my last will and testament I witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal the 17th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three Harry Gallman Seal
