and jointly & severally & firmly by these presents
witness our seals & dated this 15th day of
February 1890.

The condition of the above
obligation is such that if the above bound
John Smith formerly Elizabeth Willis
the goods chattels & credits of the estate
of Martin Waller late of said County the
which have or shall come into the hands
of him or his heirs of the said Eliza-
beth Smith formerly Elizabeth Willis or
of his heirs or persons of any person or
persons for her & the same be made do
the said Court of ordinary
the shall be thereunto compelled.

and such goods chattels & credits as will
will and truly administration according to
law and do make a just & true account
of her doings & doings therein when
she shall thereunto be required by the court
shall deliver & pay to such person or
persons respectively as they may be entitled
to the same by law and if it shall
hereafter appear that any last will &
testament was made by the deceased
and the same be proven before the court
of ordinary & Executor obtain a certifi-
cate of the probate thereof and she
Elizabeth Smith formerly Elizabeth Wiley
in such case if required under and
deliver up the said letters of administra-
tion then this obligation to be void
if she to remain in full force
