dollar to my beloved wife Nancy Bishop I give and devise
all my Lands & Tenements and bequeath to her all my
Stock Hous hold & Kitchen furniture or property of all
kind

Can she should marry I give and bequeath to her the
sum of five Dollars and I hereby appoint my beloved
friends Tho J Atkinson and John A Ellis Executors of
